

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO  
FROME FESTIVAL POETRY COMPETITION  
THE CRYSSE MORRISON PRIZE FOR POETRY**

1. The Competition is open for entries [00:00:00] 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2026 to [16:59:59] 14<sup>th</sup> June 2026 BST.
2. **The entry fee for each poem is £5.00**
3. Entrants must live in the United Kingdom and must enter online. Entries must be in English.
4. Entries for the local prize must live within five miles of Frome and follow the same terms and conditions.
5. At the time of entry, the work submitted must not have been entered into any other Competition and must not have been published in any format or location. All Competition entrants agree that once a work has been entered into the Competition, it must not subsequently be entered into any other competition or published until either (a) it has been determined that it has not won a prize or (b) after the prize winners have been revealed.
6. Entries which exceed the stated length will be disqualified.
7. Please save your work simply as its Title. Any deviations from this format will be disqualified.
8. The entries for the competition will be shortlisted by our experienced shortlisting panel. The list will then be sent to the main judge. In case of necessity, Frome Festival reserves the right to change a judge or judges without notice.
9. Shortlisted entries will be notified, and their names may be published by Frome Festival in any format and in any medium. The list will be posted on the Frome Festival website no later than 30 June 2026.
10. By entering a competition, all entrants grant permission and appropriate rights to Frome Festival to publish their entries for any purpose of the Competition.
11. The judges' decisions are final. No correspondence will be entered into.
